STAY SAFE



Call 2-1-1 or 3-1-1 to get help or ask questions.



If you have a critical emergency, call 9-1-1.



Have flashlights and batteries on hand. Make sure your phone is charged.



Have enough nonperishable food and water for every member of your household for 3 days. Don't forget any pets!
